
Creating an Echo360 video assignment in the Moodle LMS (page 1 of 2)

The video assignment feature allows students to create, edit, manage and submit video content for assessment within the Moodle LMS. Video content remains in familiar, standardised formats and locked from further editing following submission.

Create the Assignment

1. Log in to Moodle as an instructor and navigate to your course.

2. In edit mode, Click on Add an activity or resource



3. Select Assignment and click Add

- 4. In the Name and Description fields, enter information that describes the assignment, Name is required; Description is optional.
- 5. Scroll down and find the Submission types area of the Assignment settings. This is shown in the below figure:

- 8. When finished, click Save and Return to Course.


