Working with engagement scores

Engagement scores are weighted averages of student analytics that are collected within the Echo360 video platform. The weighting can be adjusted by Instructors to provide a snapshot of student engagement that is representative of their mode of instruction. The scores are therefore helpful with supporting large cohorts and particularly for early identification of struggling students.

Important Notes

- The engagement score applies to all classes included in a Section
- Updating the engagement score will automatically change the calculated student score and class average across the course

Step 1: Using the engagement presets

- 1. Click the **ANALYTICS** link on the Section page;
- 2. Select WEIGHTING from the left side menu;
- 3. Select a preset which most suits the mode of learning for the course
- 4. Click **APPLY** to confirm your selection.
- 5. Click on one of the other presets or Reset to restore the settings to a previous preset.



Step 2: Manually adjusting the engagement score metrics

1. To adjust an individual engagement score metric, click on the circular slider button and drag to the left or right to adjust the % weighting;

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- 2. Repeat for any of the other metrics;
- 3. Click **APPLY** to confirm your modifications and save the recalculated engagement weighted scores for the course.



Step 3: Viewing engagement scores

- 1. Click on STUDENTS in the left side menu;
- 2. Filter the 'Weighted Engagement scores %' in ascending or descending order by clicking on the column heading.
