
## Embedding existing Echo360 video into Canvas

Publish a capture or video to your LMS from your content Library.




## Selecting content

If a Canvas Administrator has enabled it for your institution, Echo360 provides a content embed button (also called an "easy embed button") that appears in the toolbar of all content windows. (e.g discussion, assignment, pages etc)



- 1. Log in to Canvas.
- 2. Open the course you want to post the video to.
- 3. Select to add one of the item types (+Page or +Assignment, etc.)
- 4. Click on the Echo360 easy embed icon either from the rich content editor toolbar or the plug-in menu.
- 5. You have the choice to **Choose existing Content** from your EchoVideo library, **Create Content** using the Universal Capture desktop software or Browser Capture, or **Upload Content** from your computer/device or a cloud location.




7. If you upload or create content, it is automatically copied to your EchoVideo library. This will allow you to re-use your content in multiple locations within Canvas, even across different courses.



## Choosing display options for your video




 If your institution has created custom player styles to choose from, the Player Style drop-down list will appear. Select the style you want to be applied to the player.



- 2. From the **Size** drop-down list, select the size you want for the embedded video. There are four size options.
- If appropriate, enable the option to Autoplay the video (it will play as soon as a user opens the page you are embedding it into). You can also enable Automute which will mute the sound but allow the video to continue playing.
- 4. If appropriate, set a **Start At** time. If set, the video will begin playing at that timestamp, although viewers will be able to skip to view any segment of the embedded video.
- 5. When finished, click Embed.

A preview of the inserted video appears inside the content area
