- The embed media window appears. Select either "Launch Media Picker" if the video is in your EchoVideo library or "Upload Media" if the video is on your computer or in a cloud storage location.
- In the example here, we're selecting "Launch Media Picker" as the video we want to submit is in our EchoVideo Library. Select the video you want then select Next:





Important: Once inserted, the selected video shows up as a link the video itself does not display until submission (shown below)

- Enter any comments or other information about the video you want to provide to your instructor (do not edit the EchoVideo link text).
- 8. When finished, click Save Changes. The video is displayed.
