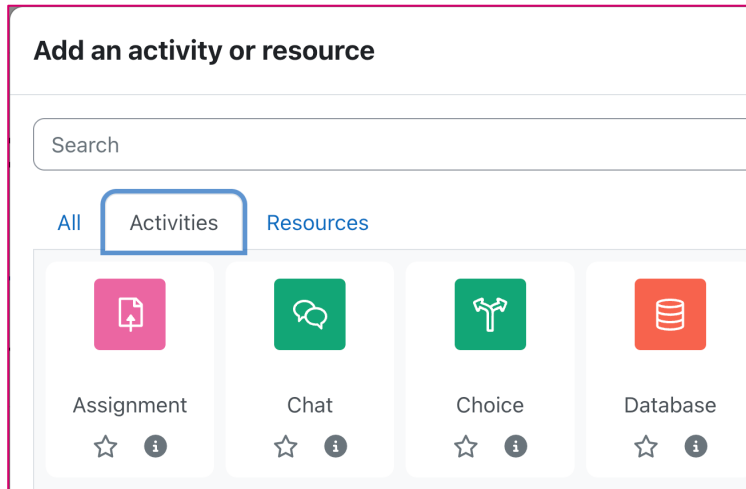


# Creating an EchoVideo video assignment in the Moodle LMS (page 1 of 2)

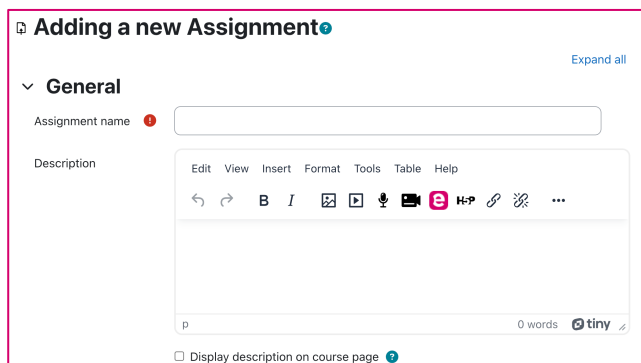
The video assignment feature allows students to create, edit, manage and submit video content for assessment within the Moodle LMS. Video content remains in familiar, standardised formats and locked from further editing following submission.

## Create the Assignment

1. Log in to Moodle as an instructor and navigate to your course.
2. In edit mode, Click on Add an activity or resource

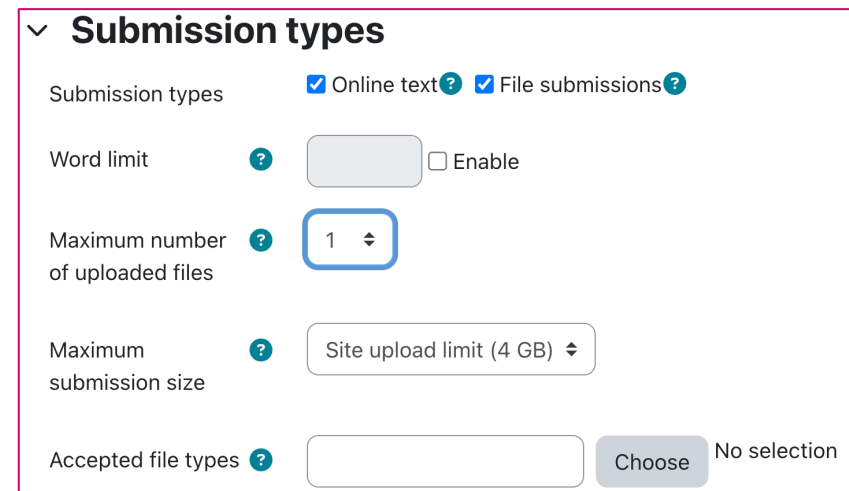


3. Select Assignment and click Add



## Modify the settings to accept EchoVideo video

4. In the Name and Description fields, enter information that describes the assignment, Name is required; Description is optional.
5. Scroll down and find the Submission types area of the Assignment settings. This is shown in the below figure:



6. In the Submission types checkbox ensure Online text is checked.
7. Complete the other fields of the Assignment settings as required.
8. When finished, click Save and Return to Course.

## Support the students submitting video

Provide students with the resources and support they need in order to create and submit video for their assessments.


We have created the student equivalent of this Quick Reference card for EchoVideo Video Assignments in Moodle LMS as modelled by the image below:

### Submitting an Echo360 video to a Moodle LMS Assignment

Moodle Assignments can now accept Echo360 videos. Follow these instructions to submit an Echo360 video to a Moodle Assignment.

**Submit an Echo360 video to the Assignment**



- Log in to Moodle as a student and navigate to your course.
- Click on the relevant Assignment that you want to submit video for.
- Click Add submission as shown in the below figure



- The embed media window appears. Select either "Launch Media Picker" if the video is in your EchoVideo library or "Upload Media" if the video is on your computer or in cloud storage location.
- In the example here, we're selecting "Launch Media Picker" as the video we want to submit is in our EchoVideo Library. Select the video you want then select Next.

*Important: Once inserted, the selected video shows up as a link - the video itself does not display until submission (shown below)*

- Enter any comments or other information about the video you want to provide to your instructor (do not edit the Echo360 link text).
- When finished, click Save Changes. The video is displayed.








