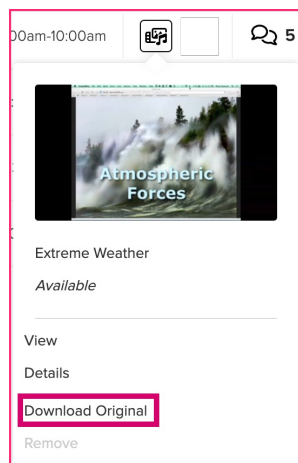
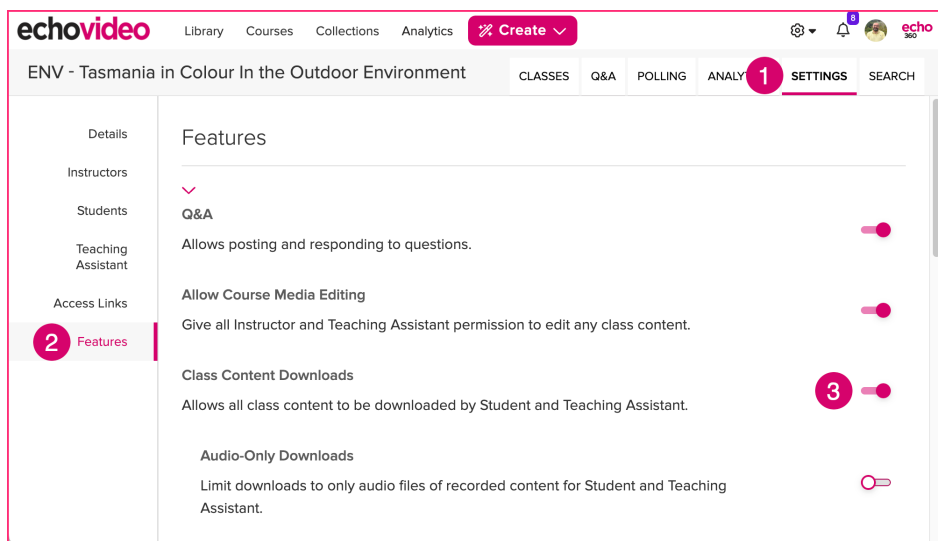


Using EchoVideo with Students with Limited Internet Access



Allowing Students to Download recorded lectures

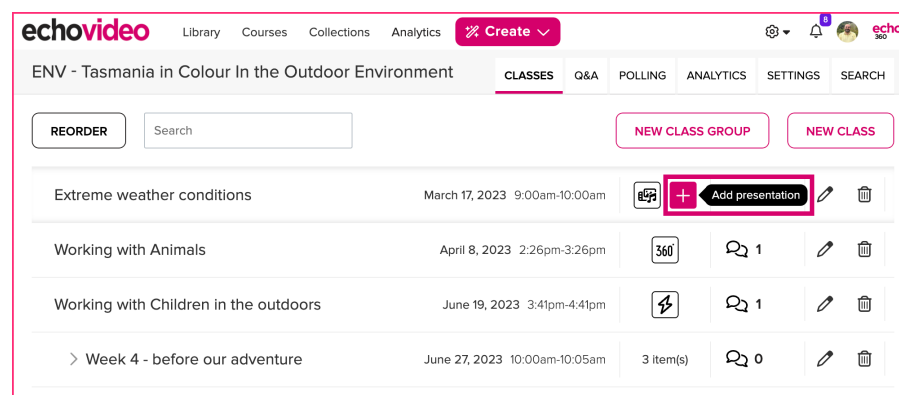
You will need to turn this functionality on under the Settings tab from your dashboard. *If this option has been made unavailable, please contact your EchoVideo administrator.*



Students will then be able to access and download the lecture from the icons in the class list. For students struggling with bandwidth, they will also have access to download the audio only.

Uploading Presentation slides into EchoVideo

Uploading your slides into the platform next to the lecture recording allows students to take time-stamped notes in EchoVideo or to download them without having to access the LMS.



Please note: you will need to ensure you upload your complete PowerPoint presentation so that students do not miss any slides. **ONLY** the original PowerPoint presentation will be downloaded from within EchoVideo's course section, even if you adapt your presentation in EchoVideo after it has been uploaded.

Adding a video into EchoVideo

If you are choosing to create shorter videos for students who are having difficulty with bandwidth, you can add them directly into the platform.

Only one video and one presentation can be added to every class. You can create a new class if needed using the raspberry NEW CLASS button.

Automated Speech Recognition

If you do not already have access, you may want to discuss turning on the Automated Speech Recognition with your institution. If you have students that cannot access the recordings, you can copy the transcript into something like Microsoft Word and send it to them. Be aware that accuracy may be dependent on accents and clarity of the speaker.
