
Easy Embed button

The text editors in Blackboard have a content embed button, also called 'Easy Embed', that makes embedding media into your LMS simple.

- 1. Open the course in Blackboard where you want to post the video.
- 2. Select the location; anywhere you have a text editor, such as a page, assessment or discussion and edit it.
- 3. In the text editor, click on the additional tools button. (+ button)




4. Under additional tools, select the EchoVideo easy embed button..



NOTE: while this is often represented by the Echo360 blue or raspberry icon, it MAY also be text depending on how your institution chooses to represent it.

5. If clicking on it opens the window as below, you have the right one.




- You have the choice to Choose existing Content from your EchoVideo library to embed, Create Content using the Universal Capture desktop software or Browser Capture and embed it, or Upload Content from your computer/device or a cloud location to embed.
- 7. If you upload or create content, it is automatically copied to your EchoVideo library. This will allow you to re-use your content in multiple locations within Blackboard, even across different courses



Choosing display options for your video




 If your institution has created custom player styles to choose from, the Player Style drop-down list will appear. Select the style you want to be applied to the player.



- 2. From the **Size** drop-down list, select the size you want for the embedded video. There are four size options.
- 3. Set any other options such as **Autoplay**, **Automute**, **Discussions** or a **Start Time**.
- 4. When finished, click Embed.
