

Embedding existing Echo360 video into Moodle

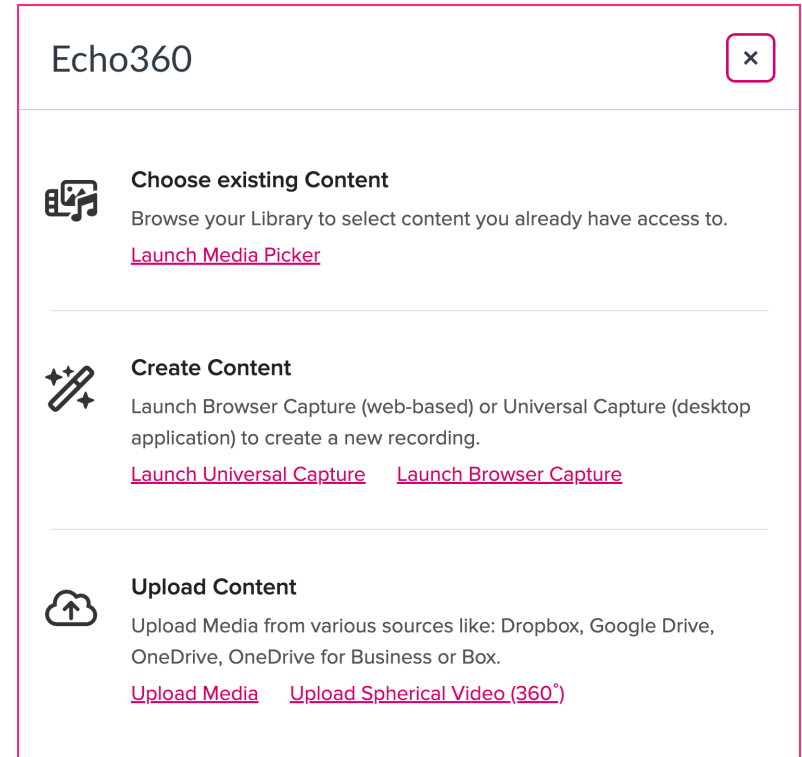
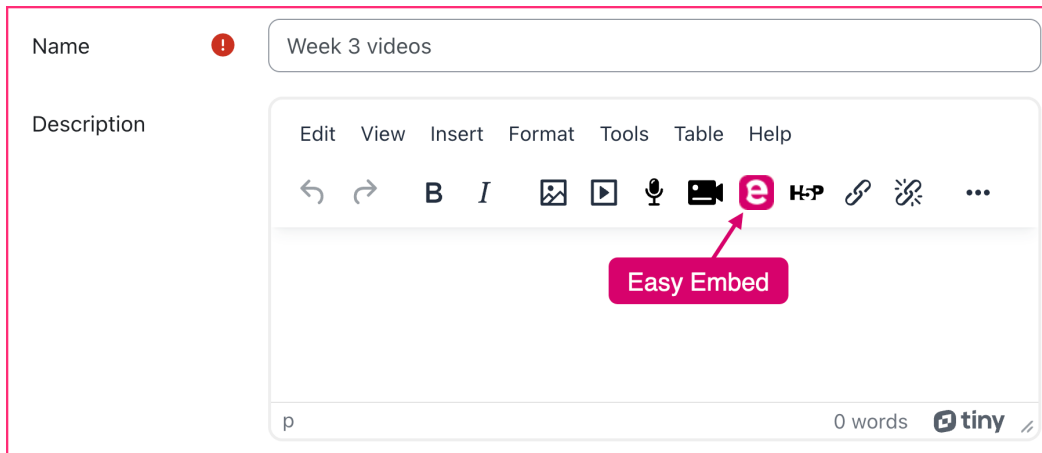
Publish a capture or video to your LMS from your content Library.



Easy Embed button

The text editors in Moodle have a content embed button (also called an "easy embed button") that appears in the toolbar of all content windows. (e.g discussion, assignment, pages etc)

1. Log in to Moodle.
2. Open the course and add one of the item types (Page, discussion, Activity or Assignment, etc.) you want to add the video to.
3. The Easy Embed is represented by the Echo360 icon in the content toolbar. Click on it to continue.



4. You have the choice to **Choose existing Content** from your EchoVideo library, **Create Content** using the Universal Capture desktop software or Browser Capture, or **Upload Content** from your computer/device or a cloud location
5. If you upload or create content, it is automatically copied to your EchoVideo library. This will allow you to re-use your content in multiple locations within Moodle, even across different courses.

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Choosing display options for your video

1. If your institution has created custom player styles to choose from, the **Player Style** drop-down list will appear. Select the style you want to be applied to the player.

2. From the Size drop-down list, select the size you want for the embedded video. There are four size options.
3. If appropriate, enable other options such as Autoplay or set a Start At time if needed.
4. When finished making selections, click **Embed**. The video will appear as text until you save the page.

5. Once saved and displayed, the video will appear on screen.

Note : If you prefer to use links to your videos, set your video options and toggle on Link.
